This has a reference to the email/what's app communication received from the assistant Director, Arvind Kumar, RCD, having reference to the subject above, wherein the States were informed to communicate any State specific order issued, for requirement of additional documents for a particular KoB, beyond the once specified under FSSA 2006. The said matter was referred to the Government and the Government of Goa has conveyed the approval to continue the existing practice of insisting on the Local Body NOC/ Trade License for every Food Business in Goa irrespective of the KOB and category.

Thus, in view of the above the said option for uploading the Local Body NOC/trade license may kindly be incorporated in the new FoSCoS system for the Goa dashboard as a mandatory requirement.
